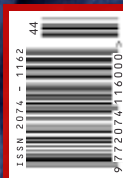

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Exposure to Traffic Exhaust Fumes Increases Risk of Lung Cancer

Air pollution, chiefly from traffic exhaust fumes in cities could have serious and sometimes fatal effect on health, according to two studies that link it to lung cancer and heart failure.

Although smoking is a far bigger cause of lung cancer, a significant number of people will get the disease because of where they live.

The study, codenamed Escape, combined data from 17 cohort studies in nine European countries covering a total of almost 313,000 people. The size of the research gives it greater authority than previous work.

It looked at the effect of long-term exposure to nitrogen oxides and particulate matter PM2.5, which has a diameter of less than 2.5 micrometres, and PM10, with a diameter less than 10 micrometres.

Among the participants, 2,095 developed lung cancer during an average 13 years of follow-up.

The researchers, led by Ole Raaschou-Nielsen from the Danish Cancer Society Research Centre, found that for every increase of five micrograms per cubic metre of PM2.5 pollution, the risk of lung cancer rose by 18%, and for every increase of 10 micrograms per cubic metre in PM10 pollution the risk increased by 22%.

The second study published by the Lancet, shows that short-term exposure to air pollution increases the risk of being admitted to hospital with and dying of heart failure.

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The scientists behind the two studies say that their findings indicate that current safety limits on air pollution are still too high and need to be lowered.

“Everybody is exposed to air pollution and it is difficult to escape,” said Dr Anoop Shah. “Our results indicate that

6 Ways Your Relationship Can Hurt Your Health



For better or worse

By Amanda MacMillan Can your relationship status make a difference in your overall well-being? To borrow a commonly used Facebook phrase, it's complicated. Research shows that strong partnerships can help us avoid illness, adopt healthier habits, and even live longer. On the other hand, troubled relationships tend to breed stress and weaken immunity.

"So many factors affect our health, whether it's the behaviors we exhibit toward each other or the habits that we pass on to each other," says psychologist Maryann Troiani, PhD, co-author of *Spontaneous Optimism*. So whether you're dating casually, shacking up, or already married, keep in mind these 12 key ways your romantic bond may influence your mind and body.

Stress levels

Surprise, surprise: Regular physical intimacy appears to reduce stress and boost well-being. One study, published in 2009 in the *Journal of Sexual Medicine*, found that people who frequently had sex were healthier mentally and more likely to report greater satisfaction with their relationship and life overall.

Sex is just one aspect of a relationship,

however. And your partner's behavior outside the bedroom can just as easily send stress levels soaring in the opposite direction. Parenting disputes, disagreements over money, or even questions as simple as who does which household chores have been shown to increase stress.

Feel-good hormones

Sex isn't the only type of physical contact that can lower stress and improve health. In a 2004 study of 38 couples, University of North Carolina researchers found that both men and women had higher blood levels of oxytocin—a hormone believed to ease stress and improve mood—after hugging. The women also had lower blood pressure post-hug, and lower levels of the stress hormone cortisol.

"These types of caring behaviors are so important: a touch on the arm, holding hands, a rub on the shoulder," Troiani says. "It only takes a few seconds of contact to stimulate those hormones and to help overcome stress and anxiety."

Sleep problems

Sleeping next to someone you love and trust can help you fully relax and embrace sleep, Troiani says. A big exception to that rule, of course, is if your bedmate keeps you up at night—by snoring, for instance, or by tossing and

turning. In a 2005 poll, people were more likely to experience daytime fatigue and fitful sleep themselves if their partner was struggling with insomnia.

Relationships can affect sleep in less direct ways, too. Research shows that relationship insecurity or conflict is associated with poorer sleep—and to make matters worse, sleep problems can exacerbate relationship problems, creating a vicious cycle.

Weight gain

It's a common belief that couples "let themselves go" after pairing off, and there may be something to it. According to a 2012 review, people tend to gain weight as they settle into marriage and lose weight when a marriage ends.

But Troiani has seen the opposite happen quite often, as well: "A happy couple can motivate each other to stay healthy—they'll go to the gym together, set goals, and feel responsible for each other." When couples do pack on the pounds, she adds, it may be a symptom of conflict, not slacking off. "Dissatisfaction in the relationship can lead to passive-aggressive eating behaviors and sleep problems, which will lead to weight gain," she says.

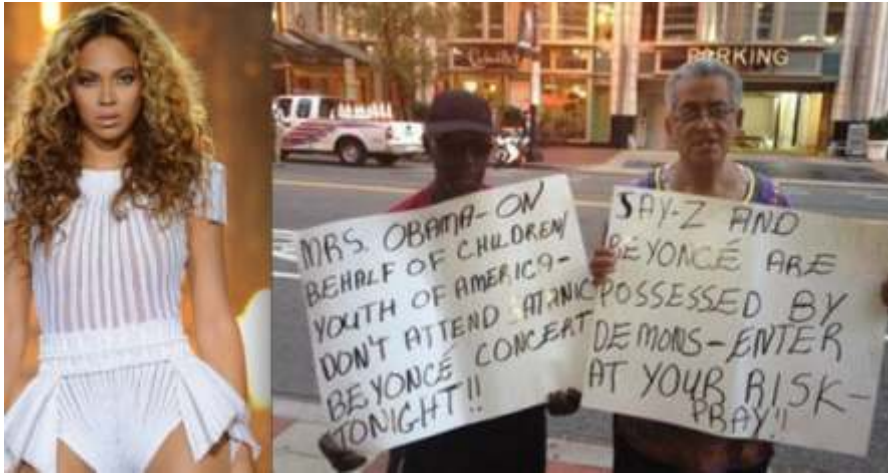
"It is necessary to set the record straight regarding the alleged adultery story written in some news mediums about Mr. Tunde

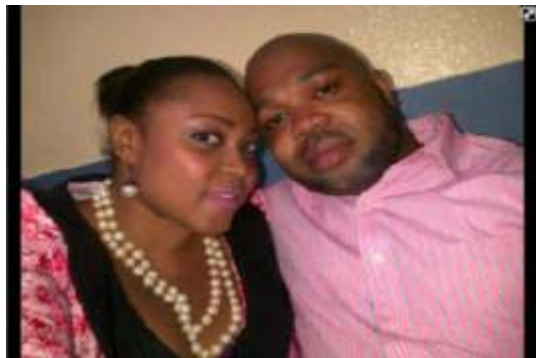

APPLE SAYS IOS 7 WILL PATCH EXPLOIT THAT LETS ROGUE CHARGERS INSTALL MALWARE

Recently, Georgia Tech researchers discovered an unusual way to attack iOS: a third-party charger with a hidden computer can install malware when an iOS device is plugged in and unlocked. If you notice DRB Lasgidi did something like that with "Selecta" which is a beautiful song too. I think that's what music here is going to turn into very soon. We're just hitting the Electronic Dance music phase now or we've been there since.

What's your relationship like with L.O.S? Those boys are cool. Those boys are my brothers.

When the news of your altercation with Mode Nine hit the Nigerian online community, you were in Dubai and you tend to always be there now and then.

What is Dubai to you?

Dubai is like my second home. I can be myself there. There's no celebrity spotlight on me and I'm just a regular person; that's what I love. Sometimes you just want to get away and just be yourself. So, when I'm there, I can write better; I can think better, I can do everything I want to do. So, that's my getaway... at least until they find it. (laughs)

Some of the L.O.S boys go to school in Dubai and, from the grapevine, we've heard that you were dating one of them – Briss. How true is this?

That's ridiculous. I mean people that know me, and know who I'm dating, know that that is just a bogus and very ridiculous story.

So, don't you want to let them know who you're dating?

No. The people that know, know and it's not like I'm hiding who I'm dating, it's just that I'm very private about my relationship. If you know, it's all well and good. If you don't, it's still all well and good.

What do you like the most about your boyfriend?

My boyfriend is funny. That's not all but for now, I'll say he's very funny.

What do you find attractive about a man?

I find it hot when a guy wears Tom Ford cologne, dresses good, looks good and doesn't sag his pants. I like a true gentleman.

In that case, do you have any celebrity crushes?

Robert Downey Jr.

In the kitchen, would you say you're a

good cook? What are your specialties?

Definitely, I'm a good cook. Everything I cook is good. I make a mean Oha soup.

So back to your Mode Nine altercation, has that hindered any progress in your career? Has it affected your corporate image, for example?

No, it didn't do anything to me. It's just that the whole experience taught me that there's a lot of learning that needs to go on between individuals. First of all, temper and tantrums – everyone needs to learn to control their temper, myself and Mode Nine included. Secondly, friendship and respect is important. I have respect for Mode Nine and he has respect for me. I think the whole thing was blown out of proportion by the media and it wasn't like that at all.

Since that is all cleared up, will we see you as the MC of an event anytime soon?

I'm focusing on my music right now. I just brought out this song and I'm still promoting it. I need to stay focused on it and I'm having a good time so that's what is key to me right now. But, if I'm going to host any gig, I'm going to make sure that everybody gets the memo that I'm getting so that there's no misunderstanding about anything. We wouldn't want a repeat of something like that to happen again.

Sometime last year, you were in the states and the UK working on your album. We also spotted you in photos with the likes of Usher and Ludacris. How did that come about? Was it because of the BET cypher? Did that open up doors?

Well, if it were in the States, I guess it would have but here it was just a cypher for people to say who was good and who wasn't. It didn't really take off anything. But, it was very good exposure and I'm happy for it. It helped as PR.

So, when you meet them – fan moment, friend moment or just business?

Back when I was much younger, not that I'm old now (laughs), I used to love Ludacris. When I would write my name, I used to write Muna Bridges (Ludacris' real name is Christopher Bridges). It was crazy like that. So, you know when you get older, things change because when I finally met Ludacris, it was like – “is this the guy I've been crushing on?” Dreams do come true but I wasn't in love like I was before. I still love him though but he's got a girl (laughs).

When will we be getting your debut album? Is it still called “The Goddess, The Hustler”?

The name may most likely change. I have to give a name that people can relate to. I haven't quite figured that out yet. We've been working. Everything so far for me has been a learning process and we still have all those records in the vault and they're still good so they will be on the album. We'll redo a few tracks but “Killer Queen” will be on the album. You should be expecting the album around December this year. I just dropped a single and next is a video. We have a lot of things to do before then but it just has to come out this year. This year is like the females year with Omawumi, Waje and Tiwa Savage all dropping albums.

Do you think you're going to dominate them with yours?

Everybody is a big star in their own right and I think the sky is big enough for all of us so it's cool.

You have a new Manager who is also a professional photographer – Paul Ukonu. Does that mean you've split with Ayo Shonaiya and his RMG Record label? RMG and I still work together in certain things. We're still family off the business

so there's no real separation. We're all one huge polygamous family. Ayo Shonaiya still works with me on my businesses, he still negotiates for me, which is part of the [music] business. Paul is my new manager and business partner so everyone is working hand in hand to make sure that this brand, Muna, goes very far. We're all together.

It seems like endorsement season for some of our biggest acts. How about your Lux soap endorsement? Will we be seeing adverts anytime soon? Is that deal still intact?

(Laughs) We're keeping our eyes open. It's been over a year since I did that so my contract is still being reviewed for a renewal. You never know, I might just pick it up again. As for endorsements, right now, I've got Dabur toothpaste. Do you use Dabur? You should. It's really good. So, you better use Dabur.

How about University?

Hmm... starting up the Rap community in my school was pretty cool. I went to Benson Idahosa University. I was just a 100 level student, just before MBGN and my school was a very Christian school so if you were rapping, you had to be very careful, and you wouldn't want to start a crew. I was able to get people from final year to first year to meet in one room because of Rap. I actually can't believe I did that but I did. We were cool Hip-Hop people and we were not afraid. We didn't get into any trouble because we were all straight-A students. Also, during NYSC, they didn't know I was a beauty queen so they asked me to come and do Miss NYSC (laughs). Then, some people used say I was forming because I had won for Nigeria and didn't want to compete in NYSC. My camp friends used to call me 'Mama'.

Smoked Whiskey Wings

You got your breast men and your leg men and your thigh men, but let me tell you something: I'm a wing man. What I love about wings is that you get a two-in-one treat when you eat them: Between the drumette and the flat, that's some good gnawing. Wings are great for weeknight cooking too, because they take very little time to prepare and cook.

NOTE: The best way to trim chicken wings is to use kitchen shears to lop off the tips and separate the pieces.

INGREDIENTS

2 dozen whole chicken wings
Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper
3/4 cup Only Sauce , plus more for

serving, optional
1/4 cup whiskey
1 tablespoon sugar
1/4 cup plus 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard

PREPARATION

Using kitchen shears or a very sharp knife, cut each wing in half to separate the flat from the drumette; cut off and discard the tip or save it for stock. Wash the pieces well, pat them dry, season liberally with salt and pepper, and set them aside in a large zip-top freezer bag. In a small saucepan, whisk the sauce with the whiskey and sugar and bring just to a simmer over medium-high heat. Remove the sauce from the heat and whisk in the mustard. Cool completely. Pour the

mixture in the bag with the chicken wings, seal the bag, and marinate in the refrigerator for at least 30 minutes or up to overnight.

Prepare a smoker with soaked wood chips and heat it to 250°F (see Cook's Notes). Alternatively, prepare a charcoal grill (see Cook's Notes) or gas grill (see Cook's Notes) for smoking and heat it to medium-low heat.

Remove the wings from the marinade and discard the marinade. Place the wings in a large, shallow aluminum pan in a single layer. Place the uncovered pan in the smoker and cook, for 2 hours. Remove the wings from the smoker and serve with more sauce on the side if you like.

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Nigerian Striker Michael Eneramo to earn €1.2m per yr with Besiktas

Nigerian striker Michael Eneramo will earn €1.2 million (which is over N255million) per year after signing a two year deal with Turkish side, Besiktas. He will also earn €10,000 per-match bonus.

The Turkish football club yesterday released a statement which read;

"Michael Eneramo has agreed terms with Beşiktaş. Eneramo will earn €1.2 million per-season in addition to a €10,000 per-match bonus. In addition to this, Eneramo will earn the same salary in 2014-15 and 2015-16 if selected for the squad over 30 times over the course of each season."

The 27-year-old striker played for Turkish side Sivasspor for a year and a half before joining Besiktas

The Arsenal boss says it is "crazy" that clubs are trying to spend vast sums of money this summer, but also admitted that he feels under pressure to splash the cash himself

Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger says Real Madrid's €115 million pursuit of Tottenham winger Gareth Bale "makes a joke" of Uefa's Financial Fair Play regulations.

The Frenchman has so far been frustrated in his attempts to reinforce his squad this summer, with Napoli outspending the Gunners for Gonzalo Higuain, while Liverpool continue to hold firm over Luis Suarez.

And when asked about Madrid's potential world-record capture of the Welshman, Wenger struggled to understand how clubs can continue to splash the cash despite

Uefa's plans to curb spending.

"It makes a joke of it," he told reporters. "It's quite amazing in the year when Financial Fair Play comes in, world football goes completely crazy.

"You wonder what kind of impact and effect it has on the football world. It looks like it has made everybody worse than before."

Arsenal have around €80m in transfer

funds available to them this summer, and sections of the club's support have grown restless that no big-name arrivals have come through the door of the Emirates Stadium so far.

"If you say we're under pressure to spend money, yes we are," Wenger added.

"But I feel more under pressure to spend the money in the right way and that's what I'll try to do. We want to spend it if it

strengthens our team. Just spending the money is not a quality.

"Spending the money, buying the right players, that's a quality, of course.

"If you can give me names who are better than the players we have currently, I am ready to talk about it."
